PRACTITIONER RENEWAL

Licenses will not be renewed sooner than six (6) weeks in advance. To renew your license, complete and return this application with the \$50 renewal fee (per license). Include documentation of 5 hours continuing education in Bloodborne pathogens and Infection Control; Return to the board office BEFORE THE EXPIRATION DATE on your license. You must notify the Board office if you have not received your license within 30 days of the date of your renewal or application submission. Failure to do so may result in a \$25 duplicate license fee. Only check, money order or credit card payment made payable to the Kansas Board of Cosmetology will be accepted. After expiration date of license, if expired less than 6 months, an additional \$25 delinquent fee is required. \$75 total for each license and a total of 8 hrs. CE.

Notice of Employment Change: All practitioners must promptly notify the Board in writing when their place of employment changes

Trainer Renewal: Should you be an approved trainer in Kansas your trainer's license will now be issued upon receipt of an apprentice application and expire at the same time as your apprentice's license. Please note, should your practitioner's license expire during the timeframe that you are training an apprentice, your trainer's license and any training that might occur during this period would be null and void.

Change of Address: The Kansas Board of Cosmetology sends pre-notification mailers to remind individuals that their license will soon expire. To facilitate this effort and to ensure that you receive such a courtesy reminder, please keep this office informed of any change of home address.

Spore Testing: Each practitioner shall clean all non-electrical instruments prior to sterilization. All cleaned instruments shall be placed in sterile bags with color strip indicators and the instruments shall be sterilized in an approved FDA sterilizer.

A spore test must be performed every three months for tattoo, body piercing, and cosmetic tattoo facilities to assure that all microorganisms have been destroyed and proper sterilization has been achieved. The results of these tests must be available at the facility at all times for inspection by the board compliance officers. Please be informed should your facility fail to maintain quarterly spore test results nor have them available at the above named facility for review at each inspection, the Board has determined that disciplinary action may be taken against your facility. This disciplinary action may include a \$500 monetary fine for each violation.

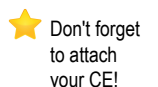
Hand washing: All practitioners shall wash their hands and nails in hot soapy water and rinse in warm water before and after a service.

Practitioners must wear gloves at all times when providing a service.
