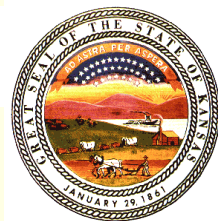

SB 123 NEWS:

- Kansas Court of Appeals held that offenders convicted of attempted drug possession do NOT qualify for SB123. See [State v. Perry-Coutcher](#). As a result, the Sentencing Commission has determined that it has no legal authority to pay for SB 123 treatment for such offenders beyond June 6, 2011.

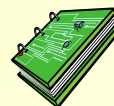
