Subject: Recognition Resolution

Resolution of the Board Approved: June 11, 2008

Whereas, Senator Vicki Schmidt, R.Ph. has made significant contributions to the Kansas Board of Pharmacy, the protection of the public health, and the profession of pharmacy.

Whereas, Senator Vicki Schmidt, R.Ph. was instrumental in the passage of the Prescription Drug Monitoring Act as an effective means to combat prescription drug diversion and to identify patients who have addiction problems and need specific help.

Whereas, Senator Vicki Schmidt, R.Ph. was instrumental in the passage of the Continuous Quality Improvement program that will provide standards to pharmacies that will improve their performance and enhance safety.
